#### PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

ATGBICS SFP-17A-C Transceivers are a high-performance, cost-effective module which has a single LC optics interface. They are compatible with the Small Form Factor Pluggable Multi-Sourcing Agreement (MSA) and Digital diagnostics functions are available via the 2-wire serial bus specified in SFF-8472. The receiver section uses a PIN receiver, and the transmitter uses a 1310nm FP laser, up to 13dB link budget ensure this module 1000Base-BX Ethernet 10km application.

Diagram of Host Board Connector Block Pin Numbers and Name

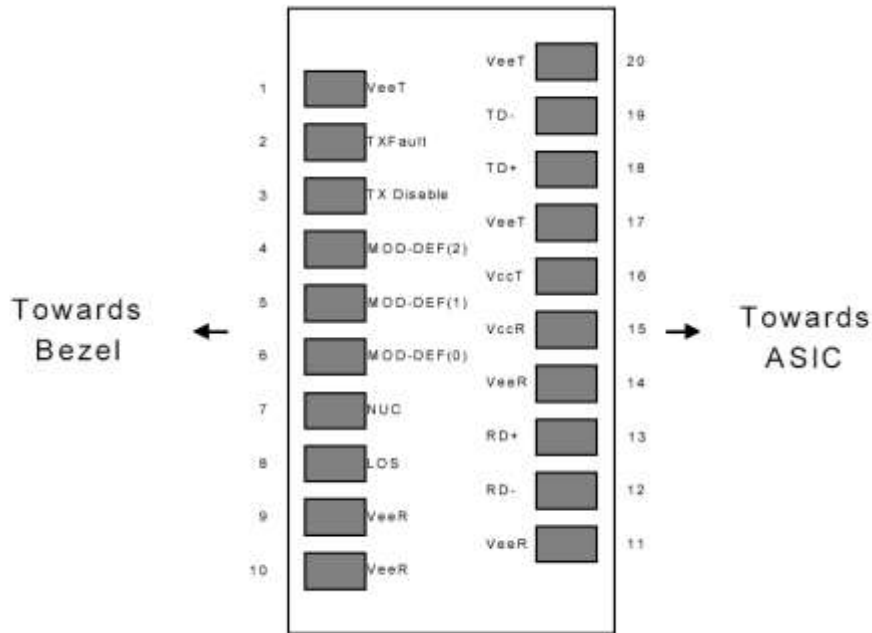


Diagram of Host Board Connector Block Pin Numbers and Names

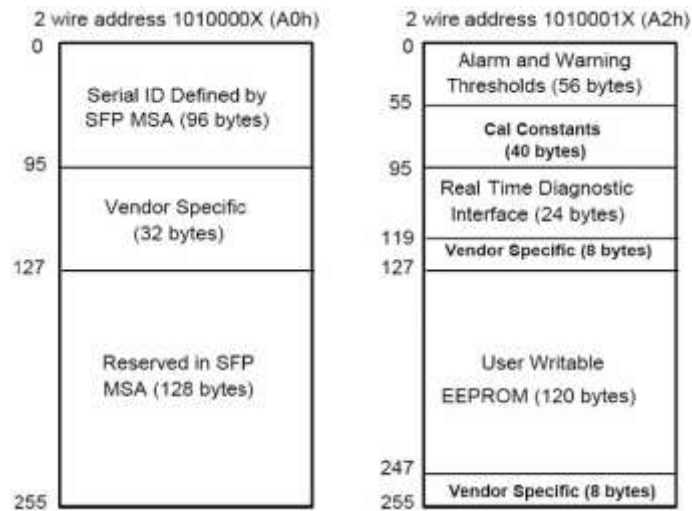

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● **SFP Module EEPROM Information and Management**

The SFP modules implement the 2-wire serial communication protocol as defined in the SFP -8472. The serial ID information of the SFP modules and Digital Diagnostic Monitor parameters can be accessed through the I<sup>2</sup>C interface at address A0h and A2h. The memory is mapped in Table 1. Detailed ID information (A0h) is listed in Table 2. And the DDM specification at address A2h. For more details of the memory map and byte definitions, please refer to the SFF-8472, “Digital Diagnostic Monitoring Interface for Optical Transceivers”. The DDM parameters have been internally calibrated.

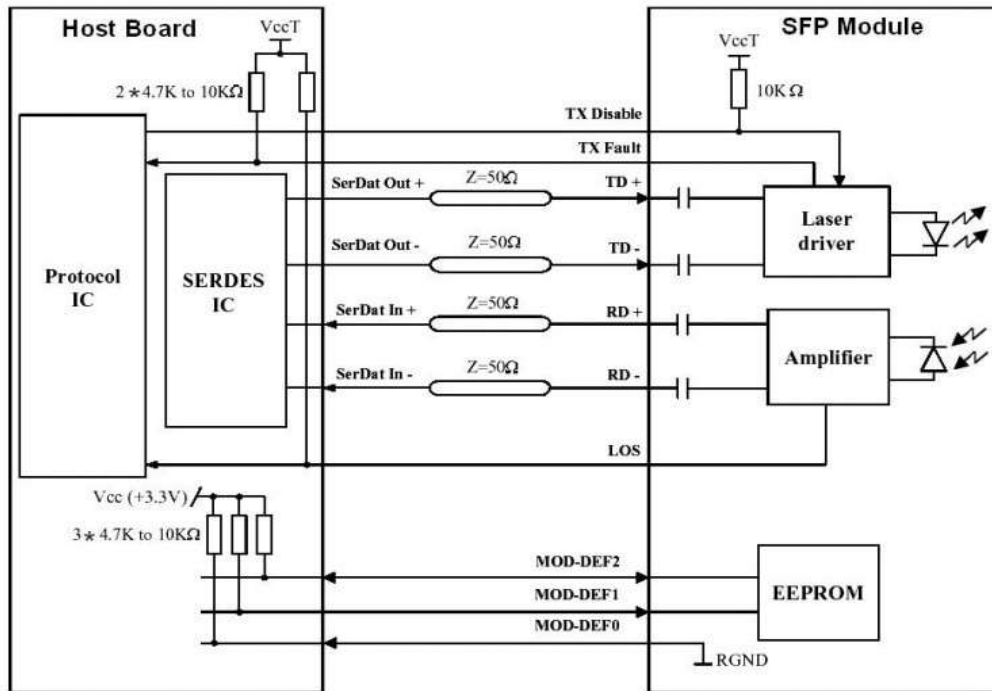
