

ROK frequently asked questions

Q: What are the requirements for selling ROK?

A: You can order ROK as a standalone option from your distributor, but you cannot sell it as a standalone OS to end customers. It must be sold with a new HP ProLiant server on which you install the OS and affix the COA label.

Q: Which servers are compatible with WS2008 Foundation?

A: All one-socket servers from HP: HP ProLiant ML110 G5, ML115 G5, ML310 G5p, DL120 G5 and DL320 G5p.

Q: How many DVDs are included in each ROK?

A: One BIOS-locked installation DVD.

Q: What is the service support telephone number?

A: The number is on the HP Customer Care Centre website: welcome.hp.com/country/us/en/wwcontact_us.htm

Q: What warranty does HP offer?

A: HP offers a one-time replacement warranty for defective media during the 90-day warranty period.
