WARNING

TECHNICAL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- . The vacuum is designed to clean pools and spas.
- . Make sure the battery cap is tightly closed before turning it on to avoid water leaking inside and damaging the product.
- . Don't use sharp objects on the filter bag to avoid damage.
- To avoid damaging the motor, do not switch it on when out of water.
- Do not close to the vacuum head when it is on to avoid overheating the motor and to extend the life of the product.
- Do not disassemble the motor without authorization from the manufacturer.
- · Working conditions:
- · Water Depth: 35 cm to 120 cm
- Water Temperature: 4°C (39.2°F) to 35°C (95°F)

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problems	Probable Causes	Solutions
Machine does not work	Battery level is too low	Replace the batteries
	Batteries are installed incorrectly	Insert the batteries correctly
Too little suction	Battery level is too low	Replace the batteries
	Debris bag is full	Remove and empty the debris bag
Abnormal noise	Debris in the motor impeller	Unscrew the suction head to clean the debris out of the impeller
	Motor impeller is broken	Return to the shop to get assistance
