

## Linux Firmware Installation Guide

### Installation

Drivers should automatically install on supported linux kernel versions. However, if Wi-Fi 6E functionality is not enabled, the **Firmware** may need to be updated.

Below are example instructions on how to update the firmware when running **Ubuntu 22.04**. Commands will vary depending on the **Linux Distribution** used.

To update the firmware of the **PAX2235-WIFI-6E-CARD** using a Linux based Host Computer, please run the following steps:

1. sudo apt-get update
2. sudo apt-get install linux-generic-hwe-22.04
3. sudo apt-get install git
4. git clone git://git.kernel.org/pub/scm/linux/kernel/git/firmware/linux-firmware.git
5. cd linux-firmware
6. sudo cp iwlwifi\* /lib/firmware
7. sudo reboot
