

Quick Guide: Using the Vivolink VLUSBCHUB3 with MacBooks

The Vivolink VLUSBCHUB3 is fully compatible with both Windows PCs and MacBooks.

Important for MacBook Users

MacBooks do not natively support multiple external displays. To enable this functionality with the VLUSBCHUB3, you must install and configure the **DisplayLink** software on your MacBook.

Set-Up Guide for MacBook Users

The VLUSBCHUB3 features two HDMI outputs. To activate the multiple display functionality, follow these steps to install and enable DisplayLink:

1. Download the DisplayLink Software

- Visit the Synaptics website and navigate to the DisplayLink macOS Downloads Section.

2. Install the Software

- Follow the on-screen instructions to install the program. Once the installation is complete, select "Yes" when prompted to open DisplayLink.

3. Enable DisplayLink at Startup

- Locate the **DisplayLink** icon in your top menu bar.
- Open the settings page and check the box for "**Launch automatically after login**" to ensure the program runs every time you start your MacBook.

Now you're all set to enjoy multiple external displays with the Vivolink VLUSBCHUB3 on your MacBook!
