In case of fire, please find the exit to escape from the fire. Never set up the tent near the river, under the tree of other objective hazards.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

For installation instructions, follow the illustrations inside the manual. Drawings are for illustration purposes only. May not reflect actual product. Not to scale.

Poles contain fiberglass; we recommend wearing gloves during assembly.

This tent is not safe if the anchorage system is not used as it may be lifted by light winds.

MAINTENANCE & STORAGE

- 1. Clean the tent and remove any stains with a sponge and cool water. Use non-detergent soap for serious cleaning.
- 2. Never machine wash or machine dry the tent. Hand wash and air dry.
- 3. Allow all parts to dry thoroughly before you repack the tent. This will prevent the formation of mold, bad odors and discoloration.
- 4. Store the tent in a dry place with a moderate temperature between 10°C / 50°F and 38°C / 100°F, out of reach of children.
