
1. Welcome






2.3 First time use

The first time the battery is used it needs to be activated by either inserting into a charging station, or by connecting it to the headset and plugging the headset into a power source. The headset will not work until a battery that has been activated is plugged into it.



3. How to wear


Adjust the headband so that the headset fits your head comfortably. The comfort pad should rest right above the ear.



The headset can be worn with the micriphone on the left or right side. It is important to position the microphone close to your mouth. The boom arm can be carefully bent for better positioning.

3.1 Attaching and detaching the headset from the wearing style


The headset is designed to be easily attached and detached from the headband or neckband, as illustrated.




3.2 Replacing the ear cushions

The headset includes both a leatherette and foam cushion. The leatherette cushion provides better isolation from outside sound. The foam cushion is more breathable and better suited for warmer environments.

Detach ear cushion




Reattach ear cushion



4. Labels

The headset is supplied with pre-attached and extra adhesive labels and transparent label covers. The labels can be used for identification or information.




4.1 Label the headset and battery

The headset and battery labels come with transparent label covers that can be placed over the labels as protection. First, write a unique identifier on the pre-attached label on the headset or battery and then peel off a transparent label cover and attach it over the label. There are extra labels and label covers if needed.



4.2 Label the headband


The headband labels are smaller than the headset and battery labels and do not include a transparent label cover. Simply write a unique identifier on the pre-attached label on the headband. There are extra labels if needed.



5. How to charge

5.1 Charge using USB cable


To charge the headset, connect the USB charging cable to the headset's USB-C charging port. It may take up to 180 minutes to fully charge the battery.



While charging, the LED indicator displays the charging status. Yellow indicates the headset is charging. Green indicates the headset is fully charged. The green LED will stay lit until the charging cable is unplugged.

5.2 Charge using the charging station


To charge the battery using the charging station, detach it from the headset and insert into an empty charging station bay. It may take up to 180 minutes to fully charge the battery.



6. How to connect


6.1 Power on

Insert the battery or press the **Multi-function** button. The LED will flash green and you will hear "On".




6.2 Power off

Press and hold the **Multi-function** button for 6 seconds until the LED flashes red and you hear "Off".




6.3 Pair with a Bluetooth device

- 1. Ensure the headset is powered on.
- Double press the Multi-function button. The headset will announce "pairing" and the LED will flash red and blue. The headset is now ready to pair.
- Go to the Bluetooth menu on your Bluetooth device and select the Jabra Perform 75 from the list of available devices.



6.4 Connect to your Bluetooth device using NFC

- 1. Ensure that NFC is enabled on your device.
- Place the NFC zone of your Bluetooth device against the NFC zone of the headset. The headset will turn on and your Bluetooth device will confirm the connection.
- 3. Select 'yes' or 'pair' to complete the pairing process.




Please note that not all phones support NFC pairing.

6.5 Pair with QR code scanner

The headset can be paired to a device using a third-party QR code scanning app to scan the QR code on the headset. Refer to the pairing instructions in your third-party QR code scanning app for more details.




7. How to use




7.1 Calls

What the buttons do					
	Answer call	Press the Multi-function button or say "Answer"			
	End call	Press the Multi-function button			
	Reject call	Press and hold (2 sec) the Multi-function button or say "Ignore"			
	Activate Voice Assistant (i.e. Siri, Google Assistant)	Press and hold (2 sec) the Multi-function button			



Adjust volume

Press the **Volume up** or **Volume down** button, when listening to music or on a call.



Mute/unmute microphone

Press the **Customizable** button when on a call. Note, when set on Voice control mode or Mute microphone mode.



Mute/unmute microphone and speaker during a call Swivel the microphone up during a call to mute the microphone and speaker.* Swivel the microphone down to unmute

^{*} Microphone and speaker mute can be configured using Jabra Direct.

7.2 The Customizable button

By default, the Customizable button activates the voice controls, or mutes the microphone when on a call. However, the button can be configured for other functions, such as Pushto-Talk, battery status, and answer/end call.

To reconfigure the Customizable button, download and use Jabra Direct on your computer.

7.3 Multiple call handling

The headset can accept and handle multiple calls at the same time.

Multiple call handling				
	End current call and answer incoming call	Press the Multi-function button to end the current call. Then press the Multi-function button to answer the incoming call		
	Put current call on hold and answer incoming call	Double press the Multi-function button		
	Reject incoming call when on a call	Press and hold (2 sec) the Multi-function button		

7.4 Voice controls

The headset recognizes English voice commands, enabling call handling without touching the headset.

Press the **Customizable button** (when not on a call) to activate the voice controls. For a list of all available commands, say: "List Commands"

List of voice commands:

- "Answer" answers an incoming call
- "Ignore" rejects an incoming call and sends it to voicemail (if available)
- "Pairing" puts the headset into pairing mode
- "Connection Status" verifies that the headset is connected to a device
- "Battery Status" announces battery level for the headset
- "Cancel" cancels voice control

7.5 Reset the headset

Resetting the headset clears the list of paired devices and resets all settings.

- 1. Ensure the headset is powered on.
- Press and hold (6 sec) both the Volume down button and the Customizable button until the LED flashes magenta and a confirmation tone is played in the headset.
- 3. The headset will automatically reboot.



You will need to re-pair the headset to your Bluetooth device after it has been reset. You will also need to clear the previous pairing to this headset on your Bluetooth device.

Jabra Direct is a desktop application designed to support, manage and enable optimal functionality for Jabra devices.

9.2 How to care for your headset

- To prevent the depletion of the battery lifetime or capacity, avoid storing the headset in hot or cold environments, such as a closed vehicle in summer or in winter conditions.
- For daily sanitization, 70% isopropyl alcohol wipes are recommended.
- When exposed to water, allow the headset sufficient time to dry. It may take up to one hour for the headset to dry thoroughly.
- Do not store the headset for extended periods of time without recharging them (max. three months).
- The headset uses the standard USB voltage of 5v +- 0.25v. It is not recommended to charge the headset using a power supply with a higher voltage.

9.3 How to clean your headset

- Apply normal dish soap and water to a cloth, making sure to wring out any excess liquid so the cloth is not dripping wet. Use soap and water only; do not use strong cleaning agents.
- 2. Gently wipe the headset with the wet cloth, making sure the headset is clean with no layer of suds on the surface.
- 3. Let the headset rest for at least one minute.
- 4. Wipe the headset clean with a cloth dampened with water only.
- 5. Allow the product to dry.
