# - Steps

#### Step 1:

Remove the backplate by pulling it off the magnets.



**Step 2:** Remove the printer plate by lifting it up, and then attach the top and base plate using the five included M5x6 countersunk screws, tightening them securely.



**Step 3:** Remove the protective paper from the Velcro. Position the printer as far forward as possible, and then press the printer down onto the self-adhesive Velcro.

If no printer is used, replace the front cover with Part C and skip this step.



**Step 5:** Mount two of the included thumb screws to the top VESA holes on the screen and hook the screen onto the keyholes of the VESA plate. Then, attach the remaining two thumb screws to the bottom two holes on the screen and tighten them securely.

Note: For screens with short threaded inserts, use the included spacers.







**Step 6:** To adjust the height of the screen, loosen the four screws slightly. Set the VESA mount to the desired height, and tighten the screws securely.



**Step 7:** Guide the cables down through the module and out under the base plate. Use cable ties and attach the cables to the crossbars. Cable ties are not included.







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
