



Statement of Volatility – Dell Pro P 22 Monitor

The P2226H Monitor contains both volatile and non-volatile components. Volatile components erase their data immediately after power is removed from the component. Non-volatile components continue to retain their data even after power is removed from the component. The following non-volatile components are present on the P2226H Monitor system board.

Description	Reference Designator	Volatility Description	User Accessible for external data	Remedial Action (Action necessary to prevent loss of data)
System EEPROM	U13	Non-Volatile memory, 16 Kbit For Storage of system setting (OSD)	No	Part placed on main interface board which is hardware/software write protected.
System Flash	U16	Non-Volatile memory, 16 Mbit For Storage of system firmware	No	Part placed on main interface board which is hardware/software write protected.
USB HUB Flash	U52	Non-Volatile memory, 16 Mbit For Storage of USB HUB firmware	No	Part placed on main interface board which is hardware/software write protected.
