No power

- Ensure that there is power at the AC outlet.
- Press & on the DVD System.

No disc detected

- Insert a disc
- Check if the disc is inserted upside down.
- Wait until the moisture condensation at the lens has cleared.
- Replace or clean the disc.
- Use a finalized CD or correct format disc.

No picture

- Check the video connection.
- Turn on the TV to the correct Video-In channel.
 - This channel is usually near channel 00.

 Or, you may have a button on the TV remote control that selects Auxiliary or AV IN channel. See your TV owner's manual for details. Or, change channels at the TV until you see DVD screen on the TV.
- Progressive scan is activated but the TV does not support progressive scan.

Black and white or distorted picture
