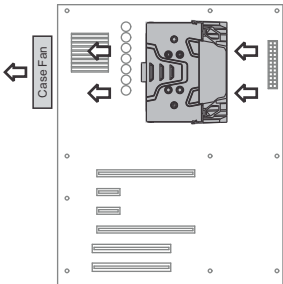


Cooler Orientation
