SSB-7720, SSM-7720, SLB-7720 and SLM-7720 Interface Brackets

SSB-7720, SSM-7720, SLB-7720 and SLM-7720 Interface Brackets are designed for use with Chief® Series Projector Mounts. See the specific installation instructions provided with the mount for additional installation information.


Unpack carton and verify kit contents. If any listed parts are missing, immediately contact a Chief Customer Service representative.

- (1) Screw, Flat Head, M3x 16mm
- (2) Washer, Flat, M4



**Only used when installing SLB/SSB interface brackets.

NOTE: Specific to SSB-style and SSM-style interface bracket installation, all appropriate screws come pre-installed as reflected in the encircled locations above. DO NOT attempt to substitute and USE ONLY this pre-installed hardware for SSB-style and SSM-style interface bracket installation.

Installation Instructions



WARNING: OVER TIGHTENING OF SCREWS CAN DAMAGE PARTS AND CAN LEAD TO SERIOUS PERSONAL INJURY AND DAMAGE TO EQUIPMENT! DO NOT over tighten screws when installing interface brackets.

NOTE: Step 1 is only required when installing an SLB/SSB interface bracket. If an SLM/SSM bracket is being installed, proceed to step 2.

1. Screw thumb screws onto 10-24 x 5/8" Phillips pan head screws. DO NOT fully tighten thumb screws at this time.
2. Turn projector upside down on a flat surface.
3. Remove the front adjustable foot on projector by lifting up the finger tab and sliding it in the direction of the finger tab (see Figure 1).

4. Place the $\frac{1}{2}$ " nylon spacers over the threaded inserts in the bottom of the projector.
5. Place the interface bracket onto the $\frac{1}{2}$ " nylon spacers on the bottom of the projector and align the mounting holes in the bracket with the nylon spacers.
6. Position the M4 x 20mm button head screws and M4 x 16mm flat head screw through the hole in the bracket and nylon spacer, and then place into the threaded inserts. Tighten all fasteners at this time to secure interface bracket to projector

NOTE: Security screws can be substituted when mounting interface bracket to projector by using the parts and installation instructions in the All-Points Security Kit.
