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HANDLING GUIDE

Do not exert force on boxes or stacked trays.



HANDLING GUIDE

Do not lift up the bundled trays from the box by pulling the tightening straps.
Lift the bundled trays with both hands.



HANDLING GUIDE

**When you cut a tightening strap, use an edged tool or scissors.
Do not remove the tightening strap by strength without a cutting tool.**



HANDLING GUIDE

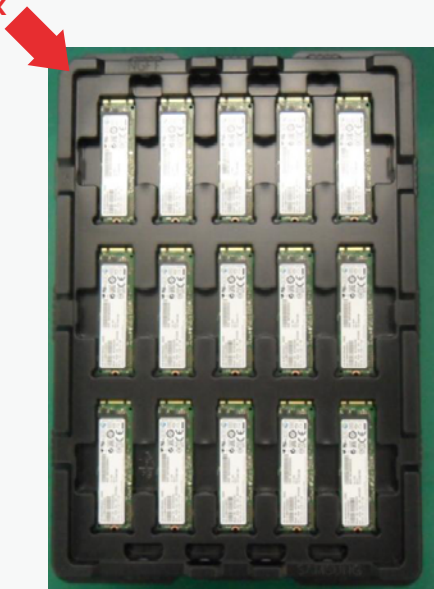
Lift each tray with both hands.



HANDLING GUIDE

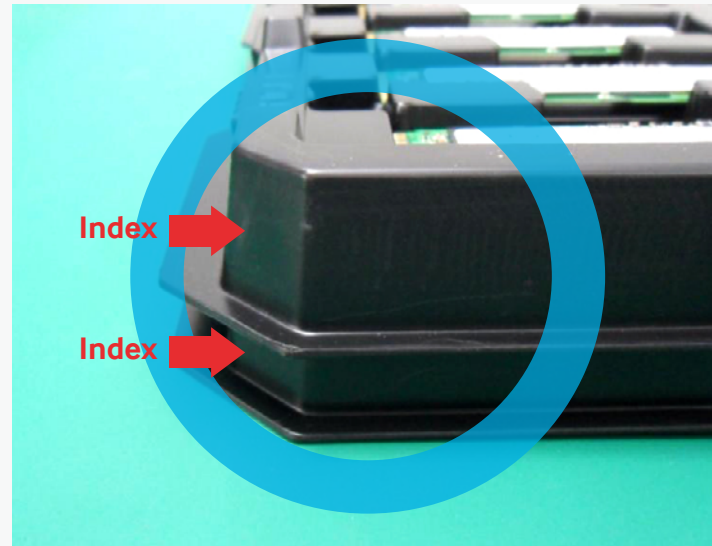
Each tray has one index corner out of its four corners. Samsung recommends that the indexes be in the same direction when stacking trays.

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HANDLING GUIDE

Samsung recommends not exerting force on SSD products when placing them.



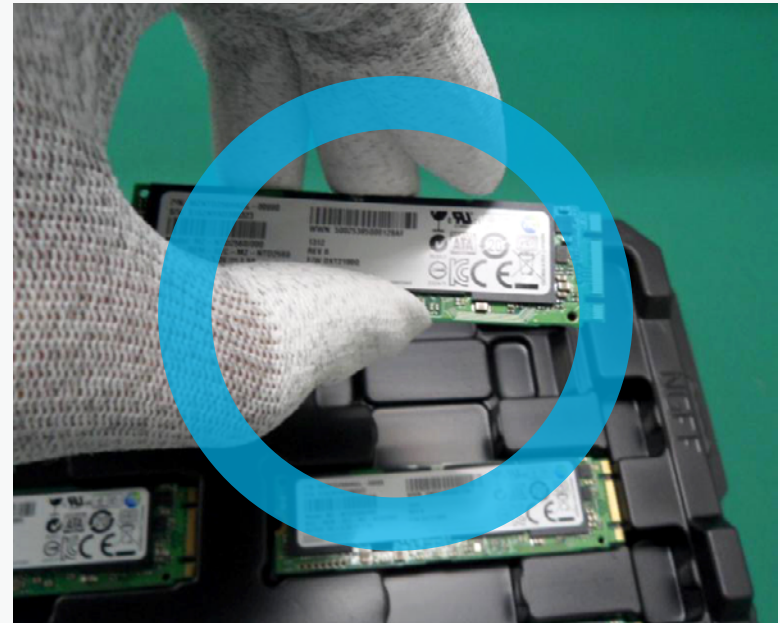
HANDLING GUIDE

Do not grip products together.
Do not pile up products together.



HANDLING GUIDE

Samsung recommends holding the edge of the PCB of the SSD.



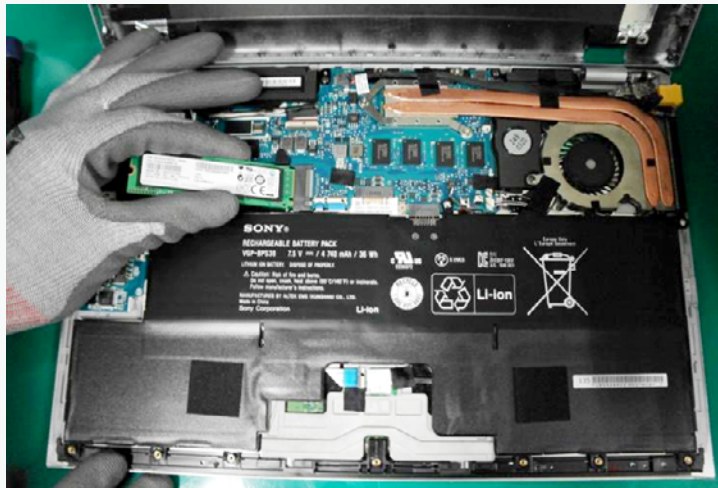
HANDLING GUIDE

SSD are delicate, and could be damaged by a fall.
If you drop an SSD, solder joints may crack.



HANDLING GUIDE

**Be careful when holding and inserting an SSD into a system.
Hold the SSD by the middle-edge with care.**
