

Like many new products, your Philips Norelco 180° Hair Clipper may take a little getting used to. If you are using an electric Clipper for the first time, or if you've been using a different brand, take the time to acquaint yourself with your new Hair Clipper.

Your Hair Clipper features a 180° pivoting head to comfortably clip even hard-to-reach areas of your head.

Throw your scissors away and put your new Hair Clipper to the test. We guarantee precise, professional results or Philips Norelco will refund you the full purchase price as long as the request is received within 45 days of purchase.

- Fully charge Clipper before using for the first time or after non-use for a long period of time.

  Battery performance is best if you recharge only when the battery is (almost) completely empty. Charging, recharging, or using Clipper at
- temperatures below 40°F or higher than 95°F adversely affects lifespan of the battery. Continuously recharging Clipper will reduce lifespan of battery. Be certain Clipper is OFF.
- 2 Insert the appliance plug directly into

- Before you start clipping, make sure that the head of the person whose hair you are cutting is at the same level as your chest so that all
- parts of his/her head are clearly visible and within easy reach.

  Only use the appliance on clean, dry hair.

  Do not use on freshly washed hair.
- Before you begin, comb the hair in the direction of growth (fig. 2).
  To achieve optimal clipping results, always move the appliance slowly through the hair against the direction of hair growth.

#### Clipping with small or large comb

- Be certain the Clipper is in the OFF position.Select the comb attachment. The table shows
- the remaining hair length after clipping at the different settings of the small or large comb. The remaining hair length is also indicated on each
- comb: — Small comb: 3-11mm (1/8 – 11/25 in.)
  - Large comb: 13-21mm (1/2 7/8 in.)
- Slide the selected comb into the guiding grooves on both sides of the Clipper swivel head and push until you hear it 'click' into place (fig. 3).
- Make sure the comb attachment locks properly into position.
- 4 Press the Hair Length Selector (1) and slide it left or right to the desired setting (2) (fig. 4). See Table 1 for settings.

  Do not slide the length selector beyond the
- highest hair length setting (5).
  The selected hair length setting (1-5) is shown in the two length setting indication windows on both sides of the length selector (fig. 5).
- When you are clipping for the first time, start at the maximum clipping length setting (#5) of the large comb to familiarize yourself with the appliance and prevent accidentally trimming hairs too short. As you become familiar with the settings, adjust the Hair Length Selector to desired trimming length.

#### Using the swivel head

- $\blacktriangleright$  At the starting clipping position of  $0^\circ$  (pointing forward), turn the swivel head 45° or 90° to the left or right to adjust the position of the cutter blades to the part of your head you are clipping (fig. 6).
- Turn the swivel head left or right to the desired clipping position. At each position you will hear a 'click' (fig. 7). Always adjust the position of the cutter blades with the swivel head. Do not turn the cutter
- 2 The swivel head allows you to hold and use the Clipper like a brush (fig. 8). Do not turn the swivel head more than 90° to the
- left or right, 3 Make sure that the flat part of the comb is always in full contact with the scalp to obtain
- 4 Since all hairs do not grow in the same direction, move the Clipper slowly over the crown from different directions (i.e. upwards, downwards and across) to achieve an even
- 5 Always move the Clipper against the direction of hair growth.
- 6 Make overlapping passes over the head to ensure that all hair that should be cut has been cut.
- 7 As you clip different areas of your head, adjust the position of the swivel head so that the swivel head position is most comfortable for you.

## Contouring without a comb attachment

- Use the Clipper without a comb attachment to clip very close to the skin (0.03 in/0.8mm).
- Be careful when you are clipping without a comb attachment as when the Clipper is turned on it will remove every hair it touches.
- Remove the comb attachment by pulling it off the swivel head (fig. 10).

  Never pull at the flexible top of the comb attachment. Always pull at the bottom part.
- 2 To contour the hairline around the ears, comb the hair ends over the ears.
- Tilt the Clipper in such a way that only one edge of the cutter blades touches the hair ends. Only cut the hair ends. The hairline should be close to the ear (fig. 11).

### Contouring with the precision trimmer

- Use the Clipper with the precision trimmer to contour the neckline, sideburns and area around the ears.
- Be certain Clipper is in the OFF position.
- 2 Remove the comb attachment by pulling it off the swivel head (fig. 10).
- Push the center of the cutter blade with your thumb until it releases from the swivel head (fig. 12).
- 4 Insert the lug of the precision trimmer into the slot on the swivel head and push until the trimmer 'clicks' into place (fig. 13).
- To contour the neckline and sideburns, turn the Clipper and make downward strokes (fig. 14). Adjust the position of the swivel head so that it is most comfortable.
- 6 Move the Clipper slowly and smoothly following the natural hairline.

### Cleaning

Clean the attachments after each use.
 Always switch Clipper OFF, unplug and remove

Never clean, replace or remove Clipper

- power supply cord from Clipper before cleaning.

  Do not use compressed air, abrasive cleaning agents, scourers or liquids such as alcohol, benzene, bleach or acetone to clean the Clipper and attachments.
- attachments with motor ON.
  Never rinse or immerse the Clipper in water or any other liquid.
  Do not apply pressure to cutters.
  Do not touch cutters with hard objects as this may damage them.

Use a soft, dry cloth to clean Clipper handle.

### During Use:

If cut hairs have accumulated in the comb area or precision trimmer, remove hairs by shaking, blowing or using cleaning brush provided.

#### After Each Use:

- Make sure the Clipper is switched OFF and disconnected from the electrical outlet.Remove any comb attachment.
