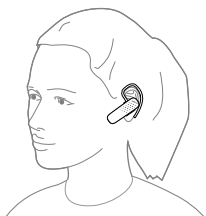

3.1 Changing EarGels

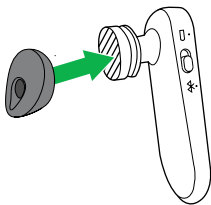
For the optimal audio experience, try each of the different EarGel sizes. The fit should feel tight and secure in your ear.



EarGel

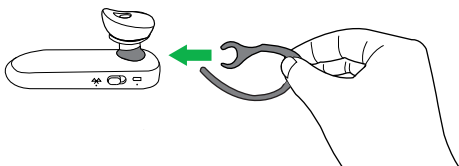


Looped EarGel



3.2 Attaching the EarHook

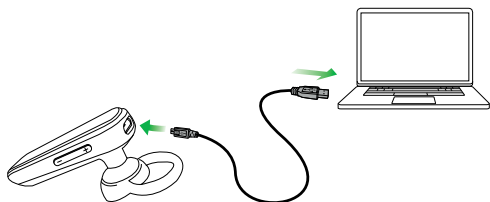
For a more secure wearing-style, try the EarHook. The fit should feel comfortable and stable on your ear. When wearing the EarHook, it is not necessary to use the looped EarGel.



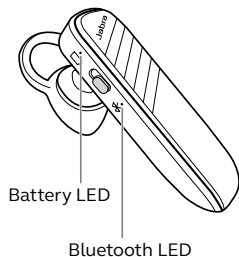
4. How to charge

The Jabra Talk 2 offers up to 9 hours of talk time.

Simply plug the USB cable into the charging port, and connect the USB cable to a power supply. It takes approx. 2 hours to fully charge the headset.



4.1 What the LEDs mean



Battery LED

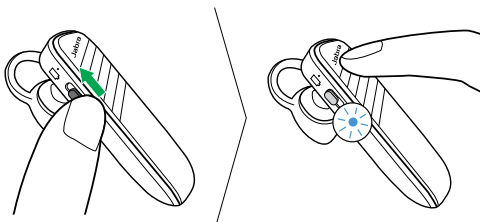
- High battery
- Low battery
- Resetting

Bluetooth LED

- Pairing mode (flashing) or Earbuds connected

5. How to connect

1. Turn on the headset.
2. Press and hold the **Answer/end** button until the Bluetooth LED flashes blue.
3. Wear the headset, and follow the voice instructions to connect to your smartphone or Bluetooth device.



6. Jabra Assist app

The Jabra Assist app is a free app that enables you to:

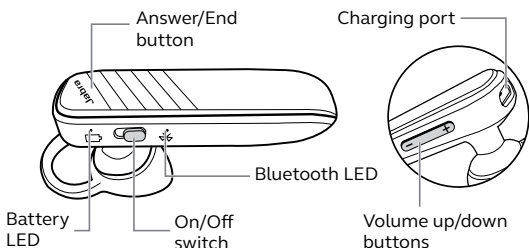
- Get access to user manual and setup guidance

7. How to use



7.1 Calls & voice assistant

Calls & voice assistant



Answer/end call

Tap the **Answer/end** button

Reject call

Double-tap the **Answer/end** button

Activate Siri/
Google Now/
Cortana

Press (1 sec) the **Answer/end** button when not on a call



Adjust volume

Tap the **Volume up** or **Volume down** button

Mute/
un-mute
microphone

Tap the **Volume up** and **Volume down** buttons at the same time

7.2 Multiple call handling

The headset can accept and handle multiple calls at the same time.

Multiple call handling



End current call and answer incoming call

Tap the **Answer/end** button

Put current call on hold and answer incoming call

Press and hold (2 secs) the **Answer/end** button

Switch between held call and active call

Press and hold (2 secs) the **Answer/end** button

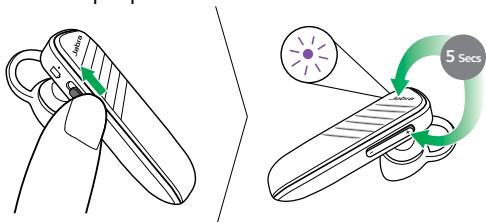
Reject incoming call, when on a call

Double-tap the **Answer/end** button

7.3 How to reset

Resetting the headset clears the list of paired devices. After resetting, it is necessary to re-pair the headset to your smartphone, or Bluetooth device.

1. Turn on the headset.
2. Press and hold the **Answer/end** button and the **Volume up** button, until the Battery LED flashes purple.



7.4 PowerNap™

To extend battery life, the headset will automatically enter PowerNap™ when the headset is turned on, but has not been used or connected for 1 hour.

To exit PowerNap, simply tap the **Answer/end** button.

8.2 How to care for your headset

- Always store the headset in the charging case and safely protected.
- Avoid storage at extreme temperatures (above 40°C/104°F or below 0°C/32°F). This can shorten battery life and may affect the headset.
