



SSD 2.5-inch Handling Guide

Do hold the side area at all times without squeezing strongly



Do wear anti-static gloves and a wrist strap to protect against ESD whenever you hold or touch the drive



SSD 2.5-inch Handling Guide

If you can't hold the side area, hold the area opposite the connectors



Do not hold the connector area



SSD 2.5-inch Handling Guide

Do not stack the SSDs



SSD 2.5-inch Handling Guide

Be careful while handling the SSD on hard surfaces



The SSD could be severely damaged if you hit it on a hard surface

The cases below should be avoided to prevent damage to the SSD


Dropping




Knocking Over



Hitting





SSD 2.5-inch Handling Guide


Do not lay the SSD on solid objects

The physical dimensions of the drive cover could be impacted, causing the SSD to fail



SSD 2.5-inch Handling Guide

Do not touch the connectors with metals and do not attempt to open the drive casing



SSD 2.5-inch Handling Guide

Do not insert or remove SSD products with partially or loosely connected connectors.



How to connect a SATA cable.

Hold the drive by its sides.
