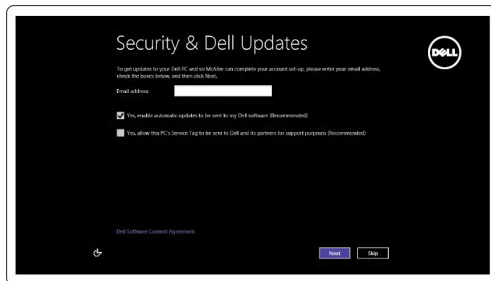

- 1 Connect the power adapter and press the power button.

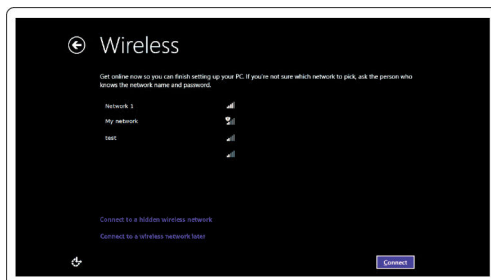


2 When your computer is switched on for the first time, you will be prompted to complete these steps:

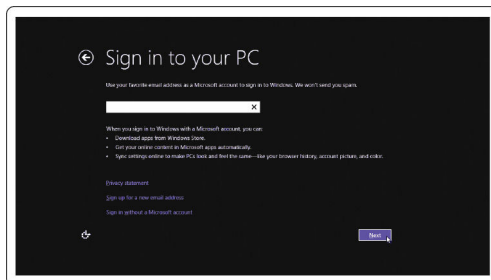
a) Enable security and Dell updates.

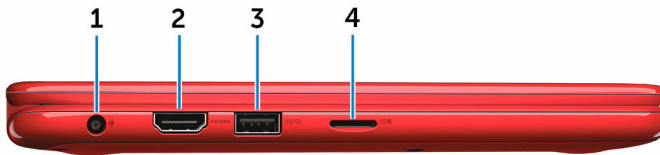

## Left



**1 Power-adaptor port**

Connect a power adapter to provide power to your computer and charge the battery.

**2 HDMI port**

Connect a TV or another HDMI-in enabled device. Provides video and audio output.

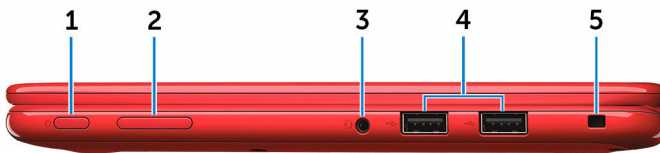
**3 USB 3.0 port**

Connect peripherals such as storage devices, printers, and so on. Provides data transfer speeds up to 5 Gbps.

**4 microSD-card slot**

Reads from and writes to media cards.

## Right



**1 Power button**

Press to turn on the computer if it is turned off or in Sleep state.

Press to put the computer in Sleep state if it is turned on.

Press and hold for 4 seconds to force shut-down the computer.

**2 Volume-control button**

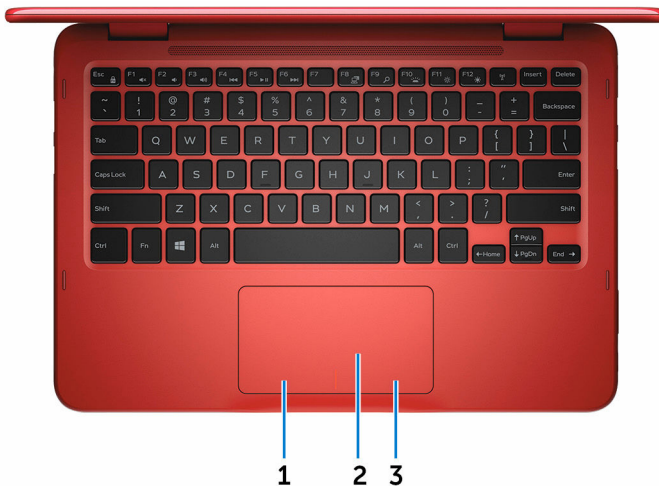
**4 USB 2.0 ports (2)**

**5 Security-cable slot**

Connect a Noble security-cable to prevent unauthorized movement of your computer.

Press to left-click.

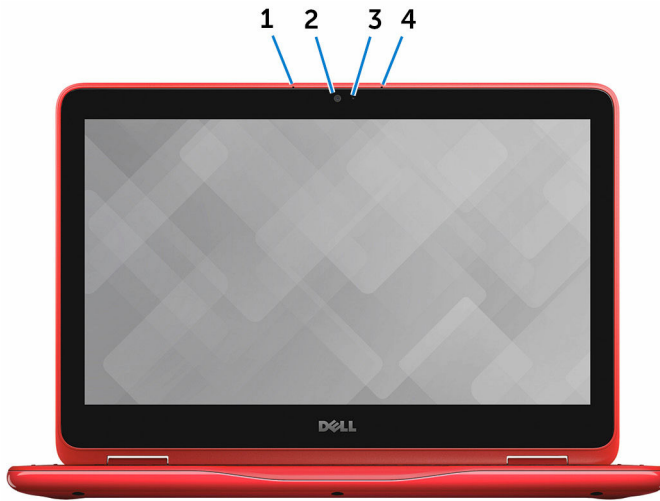
**2 Touch pad**
