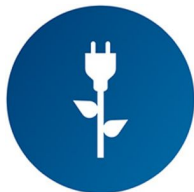

Learn about light



Colour temperature: light can have different colour temperatures, indicated in units called Kelvin (K). Bulbs with a low Kelvin value produce a warm, more tranquil light, while those with a higher Kelvin value produce a cool, more energising light. CRI: the colour rendering index (CRI) is used to describe the effect of a light source on colour appearance. Natural sunlight has a CRI of 100. The CRI of Philips LED light bulbs is always higher than 80, which ensures that colours are shown as true and natural.

Gentle LEDs, easy on the eyes



It's easy to see how harsh lighting can strain the eyes. Too bright, and you get glare. Too soft and you experience flicker. Now you can gently light up your world with LEDs designed to go easy on the eyes, and create the perfect ambience for your home.

No visible flicker

When your light flickers in quick succession it could be hard on the eyes, cause headaches and even set off an attack for those with photosensitive epilepsy. It's both unpleasant and unnecessary. LEDs can flicker because of their rapid response to the driver current. However, because Philips LEDs are designed so that variations in your driver current's output are minimised, they eliminate the factors that cause flicker. So, you won't see it, not even a hint.
