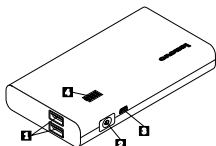

Parts and locations

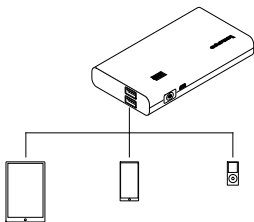


- 1** USB 2.0 connectors

Turning on/off the power bank

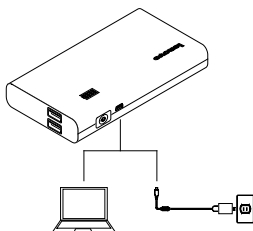
- To turn on the power bank, press the power button or connect a USB device to the power bank.
- To turn off the power bank, press and hold the power button until it is turned off. In addition, if no device is connected to the power bank, the power bank automatically turns off in a few seconds.

Charging a device



Note: Ensure that you use the USB cable coming with your device or with the power bank to charge your device.

Charging the power bank



To charge the power bank, connect the power bank to ac power or your computer.

Note: If the power bank is turned off due to short-circuit protection, charge the power bank to activate it.

Battery status indicators

Press the power button and then check the battery status indicators.

Battery status indicators	Battery power remaining
Four indicators are lit.	75%–100%
Three indicators are lit.	50%–75%
Two indicators are lit.	25%–50%
Only one indicator is lit.	≤ 25%
No indicator is lit or only one is blinking.	Depleted. Charge the power bank.

Safety information

- Press the power button to check the battery status before using the power bank.

 - Stop using the battery if it is damaged, or if you notice any discharge or the buildup of foreign materials on the battery leads.
